



The Scholarship Fund for Inner-City Children Invites Families to Apply for a Partial-Tuition Scholarship

Facts About The Scholarship Fund

- For families with children in grades K-12 attending Catholic schools within the Archdiocese of Newark (Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Union Counties).
- Scholarships are based upon financial need and are awarded without regard to religion, race or ethnicity.
- Currently the SFIC General Scholarship Fund awards a \$1,000 tuition assistant grant to elementary and high school students entering grades K through 12. (All Pre-Kindergarten programs are not eligible).
- Scholarship applications for 2015-2016 school year will be available on-line starting **January 1, 2015** at www.sficnj.org.
- Deadlines for applications is **April 15, 2015**.
- Financial documentation is required along with the completed application.
- A **\$30** non-refundable application fee is required (one per family).
- Only one scholarship per student will be awarded. Students in grades K-8 receiving tuition assistance from The Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF) program are not eligible for The SFIC scholarship.
- All applicants will be notified of our decision **on or before May 29, 2015**.
- Scholarship payments are made directly to the schools.

Applications will be available by visiting our website at www.sficnj.org. Partial-tuition scholarships are awarded based on financial need without regard to race, religion, or ethnicity.

The deadline to submit your completed application is April 15, 2015.

Being a current scholarship recipient does not guarantee an automatic scholarship award for the 2015-2016 school year. Current recipients as well as all new applicants must submit a completed application every year along with a \$30 application fee and the required financial documentation. In addition, all previous financial award amounts are not guaranteed and can be changed from year to year.

All applicants will be notified of our decision **on or before May 29, 2015.**
